

What is Green Family Foundation NeighborhoodHELP™?

The Green Family Foundation NeighbrrhoodHELP™ is a Health Education Learning Program

The program assigns teams of students and outreach workers to willing households with the goal of helping them improve their health and quality of life. We offer help in using health and social services better, or if needed, finding these services for your household.

The program teaches FIU medical, nursing, social work, law, and public health students how health, illness, and health care affect people outside of the doctor's office.

Community outreach workers help you find health and social services in your community and help you better understand and use our program.

A licensed doctor (Community Doctor), nurse, and social worker is assigned to every home and supervises FIU students.

The Community Doctor provides care in the home or at a designated health care center to any household member who is uninsured or does not have a primary care physician.
